

What is Hepatitis A?

Hepatitis A is a virus that causes liver disease.



a | Hepatitis A virus might productively infect T helper 2 (TH2) cells preferentially and eliminate them.

b | Hepatitis A virus might bind to T-cell immunoglobulin mucin 1 (TIM1) and block the development of TH2 cells.

c | Hepatitis A virus might bind to polymorphic variants of TIM1 on naive T cells and enhance the development of TH1 cells.

What can Hepatitis A do to your child?

Hepatitis A can cause many symptoms, including:

- Fever
- Nausea and stomach pain
- Loss of appetite and tiredness
- Yellowing of the skin and the whites of the eyes
- In rare cases; Hepatitis A can cause death

Is my child at risk?

- All children are at risk.
- Ask your doctor how to help protect your child.

How does it spread?

- Person-to-person contact
- Eating or drinking something that has been contaminated with the virus.
- Some people can spread Hepatitis A without showing symptoms.
