1. Skoda Yeti

When to expect: November 2010

Estimated Price: Rs 15 lakhs (basic model)

When to expect: November 2010

Estimated Price: Rs 4.5-6.5 lakhs

Tata Motors had displayed the Venture at the Auto Expo this year in New Delhi. The Venture is a seven-seater van which will be powered by a 1.4-litre diesel engine which churns out 70bhp and it is based on the Super Ace platform. This is the tried and tested engine that came strapped in the Ta...

3. Mitsubishi Lancer Evolution X

When to expect: Late 2010

Estimated Price: Rs 45-50 lakh

The Mitsubishi Evo X was introduced as a concept (named as Concept-X) at the Tokyo Motor Show in 2005. This was designed by Omer Halilhodzic. Later on Mitsubishi unveiled the second concept car, the Prototype-X at the 2007 North American International Auto Show. Mitsubishi India launched the Cedia i...

4. Nissan Sunny

When to expect: End 2010

Estimated Price: Rs 7 lakh

The Nissan Micra is an important car for Nissan in India and the company has a lot resting on the success of the Micra. 5. Toyota Etios

When to expect: Late 2010

Estimated Price: Rs 4.5-7 lakh

6. Chevrolet Beat LPG

When to expect: Late 2010

Estimated Price: Rs 4-5 lakh

GM India has been one of the first automakers who have taken the green initiative in India. Chevrolet had launched the Optra CNG, then alternative fuel variant of the Spark. Recently, they had launched the Chevrolet Aveo CNG.

7. Maruti Suzuki Kizashi

When to expect: November 2010

Estimated Price: Rs 18 lakh

Suzuki has a solid reputation for smooth, powerful performance. Keeping that in mind, the Suzuki Kizashi, a mid-size car, was unveiled in the United States on July 30, 2009. The Kizashi went on sale in Japan on October 21, 2009, in North America on December 1, 2009, and in Australia on May 11, 2010....

8. Maruti Suzuki SX4 Diesel

When to expect: Mid 2011

Estimated Price: Rs 9 lakh

Maruti Suzuki's men were back in the form of the SX4 with a 1.6l engine powering the car with 101 horses. The SX4 design is suitable for Indian roads with its high ground clearance and 15-16 inch tyres. After the huge success of the diesel variants of the Swift and Dzire over their respective petrol...

9. Nissan NV200

When to expect: Early 2011

Estimated Price: Rs 5-8 lakh

Nissan could launch a MPV called NV200 for the Indian car market. Nissan plans to manufacture the NV200 in a joint venture with defence and commercial vehicle manufacturer Ashok Leyland. The Nissan NV200 is built on the modified Renault-Nissan B-Alliance platform and will have the 1.5dCi engi...

10. Tata New Safari

When to expect: Mid-2011

Estimated Price: Rs 7-11 lakh

Tata is expected to update the existing model of the Tata Safari. The Safari will be powered by the same 2.2-litre 140bhp engine which propels the current Safari and will have airbags and ABS as extra added safety features.

11. Skoda Laura RS

When to expect: March 2011

Estimated Price: Rs 15-17 lakh

Skoda plans to get their super performer the Laura RS (known as the Octavia RS in international markets). The Laura RS has a 2.0TSI engine which produces a whooping power of 200bhp and was seen in India at the performance show November 2009 in Mumbai and even at the Auto Expo'10 in New Delhi.

12. Chevrolet Spark Electric

When to expect: Early 2011

Estimated Price: Rs 3.5-5 lakh

GM India is ready to make public the electric version of its entry level small car, the Chevrolet Spark. The Spark will feature two electric versions, one with a conventional lead acid battery and another with more expensive lithium ion batteries. The electric motor has been developed by GM I...

13. Nissan Murano

When to expect: Early 2011

Estimated Price: Rs 35-40 lakh

The name 'Murano' originates from the region of Venice, Italy which is known for hand blown glass production. The Murano was nominated for the North American Truck of the Year award for 2003 and even named the best premium mid-size SUV by AutoPacific. The Murano, when launched, will be one of...

14. BMW X1

When to expect: January 2011

Estimated Price: Rs 27 lakh (on-road, Mumbai)

BMW plans to launch the X1 in India. The X1 will be the smallest SUV from the BMW stable and will come with 1.8-litre petrol engine or the 2.0-litre diesel engine. The BMW X1 will be made available in Corporate and Highline trim levels. The BMW X1 is based on the 3-series platform and will b...

15. Chevrolet Beat Diesel

When to expect: Early 2011

Estimated Price: Rs 4.5-5.5 lakhs

After launching the Beat petrol, Chevrolet will now launch the Beat diesel for the Indian market. The diesel variant is expected to launch by early 2011. The Beat should be powered by a 1.0-litre or a 1.2-litre diesel engine. The diesel engine will help GM India to increase their numbers and help th...

16. Fiat Linea 1.6 Multijet

When to expect: Late 2011

Estimated Price: Rs 11 lakh

When to expect: Mid-2011

When to expect: Early 2011
